## Children's Basic Needs Program

Provided 4,547 backpacks, pairs of shoes, pajamas, toys and bikes to children

## Family Connections Program

Connected 587 families, including 997 parents and 2,731 children

Trained 139 parents within 106 families  
Supported over 100 parents in groups

*"Families have a need for training that helps them with parenting children from backgrounds of trauma."*



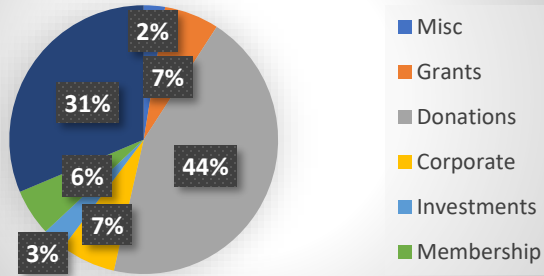
## Community Awareness Program

685 parents and children celebrated foster care and adoption together

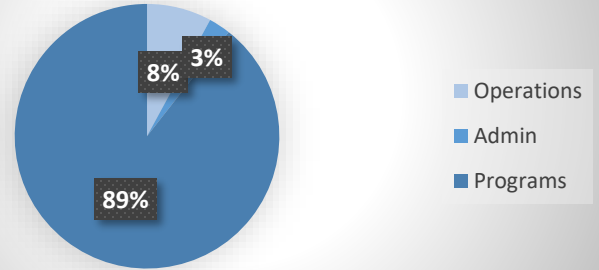
*"It takes community support to help us raise our kids."*
